Some cellular networks are being over loaded due to an increased usage. This makes them unreliable in an emergency situation. It is important to have a secondary phone system such as a landline as a backup.

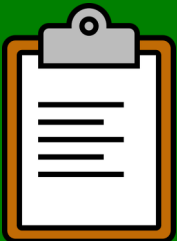


Landlines have their own power source with battery back up that is not linked to the power grid.

What Can You Do To Protect Yourself?



As a part of your at-home emergency response plan, identify the location of the nearest landline. This could be your home phone, a neighbour's landline, or a local business, or government buildings.

24/7 landlines can be found at the Esso (602 12 St) and your RCMP dispatch (639 11 St).



It is important to share this information with all members of your family to ensure they have access to a secondary phone system.
