

Bassano Rodeo Grounds Rules and Guidelines

The Town of Bassano has approved individual and organized groups to use the Bassano Rodeo Grounds. Rules and regulations have been developed in order ensure the safe use of this open-air facility.

You **must** check in with the Town of Bassano BEFORE your initial use of the rodeo grounds by emailing assistant@bassano.ca or by calling 403-641-3788.

Users must adhere to all public health orders and the following rules:

- Users should maintain physical distancing of at least 2 metres from others, unless they are from the same household, cohort, or sports cohort group (a sports cohort is 50 people or less including participants and coaches).
- Users should not share common equipment unless users are from the same household or sports cohort. If common equipment is required (eg. racing barrels), it is the responsibility of the user to clean and disinfect equipment prior to and after use.
- Rodeo arena gates are always to be left open to reduce common touch points unless approved by the Town of Bassano for specific use (eg. calf roping).
- After your activities/practises have ended, please leave the grounds to reduce contact between users.
- All items taken into the grounds by the user MUST be removed after every use. This includes any garbage or disposable items.
- Organized play in sports cohorts is permitted. Instructors and participants should continue to maintain 2m of physical distancing when at all possible. Coaches and responsible persons must be aware of public health orders and proper hygiene practises.

MISUSE OF THIS FACILITY COULD RESULT IN USERS BEING BANNED

Caution should be taken around common touch points; users are responsible for maintaining their own hygiene.

- Refrain from touching your face with unclean hands.
- Carry and use hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol content.
- Wear a mask to help limit the risk of spread to others if you will be within 2 metres of people other than members of your own household, cohort, or sport cohort.
